

TOWN OF HAMPSTEAD: TRANSFER STATION REGULATIONS

Please note: Demolition Materials will not be accepted at the Town Facility. Brush is only accepted on dates below.

Transfer Station Permits

Transfer Station Permits are required to access the Kent Farm Facility. Permits must be purchased from the Town Clerk (\$20.00/year) and must be placed in the lower left-hand corner of your windshield. One day permit \$20.00 (passenger vehicle, pickup truck). One day permit U-Haul vehicle \$20.00. The resident is required to purchase a transfer station permit along with a one day pass.

Allowable Items for Disposal: (large items should be disassembled)

Bulk items, including sofas, chairs, mattresses, etc. Metal items, appliances, electronics (televisions, monitors, computers)

Disposal Coupons

Residents are required to purchase specific dollar coupons at the Town Clerk's Office for disposal of:

Car & light pick-up truck tires	\$ 4.00 (Rims must be removed)
Appliances containing Freon	\$20.00
Television/Monitors up to 24 inches	\$10.00
Television/Monitors over 24 inches	\$20.00
Console Television	\$30.00

Non-Allowable Disposal Items (due to rising disposal fees and State regulations)

No shingles, commercial wastes, hazardous wastes or yard waste, treated or manufactured building debris or propane tanks. No residential refuse or garbage.

Transfer Station Hours

The Kent Farm Transfer Station is open the following Saturdays for **bulk disposal only**, 8:00 am to 4:00 pm

April 09, 2016	August 13, 2016
May 14, 2016	September 10, 2016
June 11, 2016	October 08, 2016
July 09, 2016	November 12, 2016

The Kent Farm Transfer Station is open the following Saturdays for **brush & leaves disposal only**, 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. Please note: grass clippings are accepted, but these must be separated from brush and leaves since clippings are composted.

April 16, 2016
May 16, 2016
October 15, 2016
November 19, 2016

Directions to the Kent Farm Transfer Station

From the Town Office Building on Main Street, follow Route 121 to Kent Farm Road, turn right on Kent Farm Road. Follow Kent Farm Road, bearing left at the "Y". The transfer station is approximately 1 mile further on the right.

Commercial Operators

Commercial operators, including general contractors who contract with Hampstead residents, to remodel and/or demolish buildings or any parts there of, will be considered to be commercial ventures and will not be admitted to the landfill. We suggest Raymond Transfer Station-Route 107 (Prescott Rd,) Raymond, NH. (603-778-2116)
