

ORDINANCE
ADOPTED AUGUST 28, 1996
and April 14, 1997

The Board of Selectmen of the Town of Hampstead, New Hampshire, pursuant to RSA 41:11 and 47:17, hereby adopt and amend the following regulation, originally adopted May 11, 1992:

Uniformed Police Officers shall be present at all times, when any roadside or road project work is being done, if said project interferes with the normal flow of traffic. Said Officers shall be assigned by the Chief of Police, and all costs will be borne by the Contractor. The rate of pay to be determined by the Selectmen.

The following is a list of roads that will require the hiring of a Special Duty Police Officer:

Brown Hill Road
Central Street
Depot Road
Emerson Avenue
East road
Hunt Road/Frontage Road
Kent Farm Road
North Salem Road
Old Danville Road
Route 111
Route 121-A
Route 121
Wash Pond Road
West Road

and any other areas, as may be determined by the Chief of Police.

This policy is for the safety of the general public and for the safety of all workers on said project.

A penalty of up to \$500.00 will be assessed.
